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In the Declaration of Independence, it states, "We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that **they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights**, that among these are Life, **Liberty** and the pursuit of Happiness."

These mortal men, referred to as "America's founding fathers" understood and declared to the world that every man has the right to Liberty which cannot be taken or given away, because that right was granted to all men by God.

The darkest periods in the millenniums of man's existence since Adam, were when a small number of men decided to rule over men as god, with the first priority to take away men's God-given Liberty.

From Nimrod to Caesar, the Scriptures record the pattern of godless rule and the crushing oppression that resulted from it.

But God did not intend for men to live oppressed. Despite not being in the Lord's Church, all of mankind enjoys this Liberty given by God, and is also permitted a number of other godly blessings.

For example, all men were "*made just a little lower than the angels, and are crowned with glory and honor.*" (Psalms 8:5). And God also "*maketh His sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust.*" (Matthew 5:45). And all men can hear the witness of God's goodness as "*the heavens declare the glory of God, and the firmament sheweth his handywork. Day unto day uttereth speech, and night unto night sheweth knowledge.*" (Psalms 19:1-2). These and other blessings are given to all men from God.

But there are certain Liberties from God that are given only to those who seek the things of God.

- ★ The liberty to pray and be heard in Heaven – Jn 9:31
- ★ The liberty to be free and at peace, in mind and conscience, before God and man – Acts 24:16
- ★ The liberty to be free from bitterness, hate, and guile and live in the fruit of the Spirit. – Gal 5:22
- ★ The liberty of possessing the Spirit of God and a hope in the Resurrection of the dead. – Rom 8:11

Let us refer to these as just a few of the "Greater Liberties" that can only be found in the Lord's Church.
