A Soldier for Life

Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends. ~ John 15:13

What would cause a young man to leave the comforts of his family and friends to engage in military service? As one brother in the Lord's church put it, "To help people." Not the standard response when a newly recruited soldier is asked, Why did you join the military? But for Ayden Twaddell, that is his motive.



He wanted to be an EMT (emergency medical technician) to help people and found being a medic in the Army National Guard was a way to accomplish his goal.

EMTs are trained to respond quickly to emergency situations regarding medical issues, traumatic

injuries and accident scenes. They provide emergency medical care to the critically ill and injured. Depending on where they work, EMTs may be solely responsible for the treatment and transportation of their patients. When asked how he views his profession: "I am trained to stop the dying process." And EMTs on the scene often have a short window of time to do that.

His motive for being a medic in the military is to be ready to help people anywhere he would be sent. This would include aid to those thrown into the many tragic events that happen in the world, whether it be natural disasters, outbreak of disease or war.

On October 23, 2017, Ayden reported for his first day of duty with the 1st Battalion, 161st Field Artillery Regiment, beginning with boot camp at Fort Sill, Oklahoma, approximately 85 miles southwest of Oklahoma City.

Ayden completed his medical training at Fort Sam Houston in San Antonio, Texas, graduating in May 2018. Fort Sam Houston is acknowledged as the largest and most important military medical training facility in the world and is known as the "Home of Army Medicine" and "Home of the Combat Medic."

Ayden's civilian job complements his interest in the medical field as an anesthetic technician at Mercy West Hospital in West Des Moines.

As a Christian soldier he also takes opportunities to teach salvation to others. "Some guys didn't want to hear it. And some guys showed interest. Even if they didn't care, at least I know I've tried."

When asked about his mind as a Christian regarding being in a profession where he will witness the death of the unsaved, specifically if called into an actual war situation, he said, "I would pray a lot and keep my faith in God. I will only fight if I have to. I'm there to do my job, which is save people's lives, not take them."

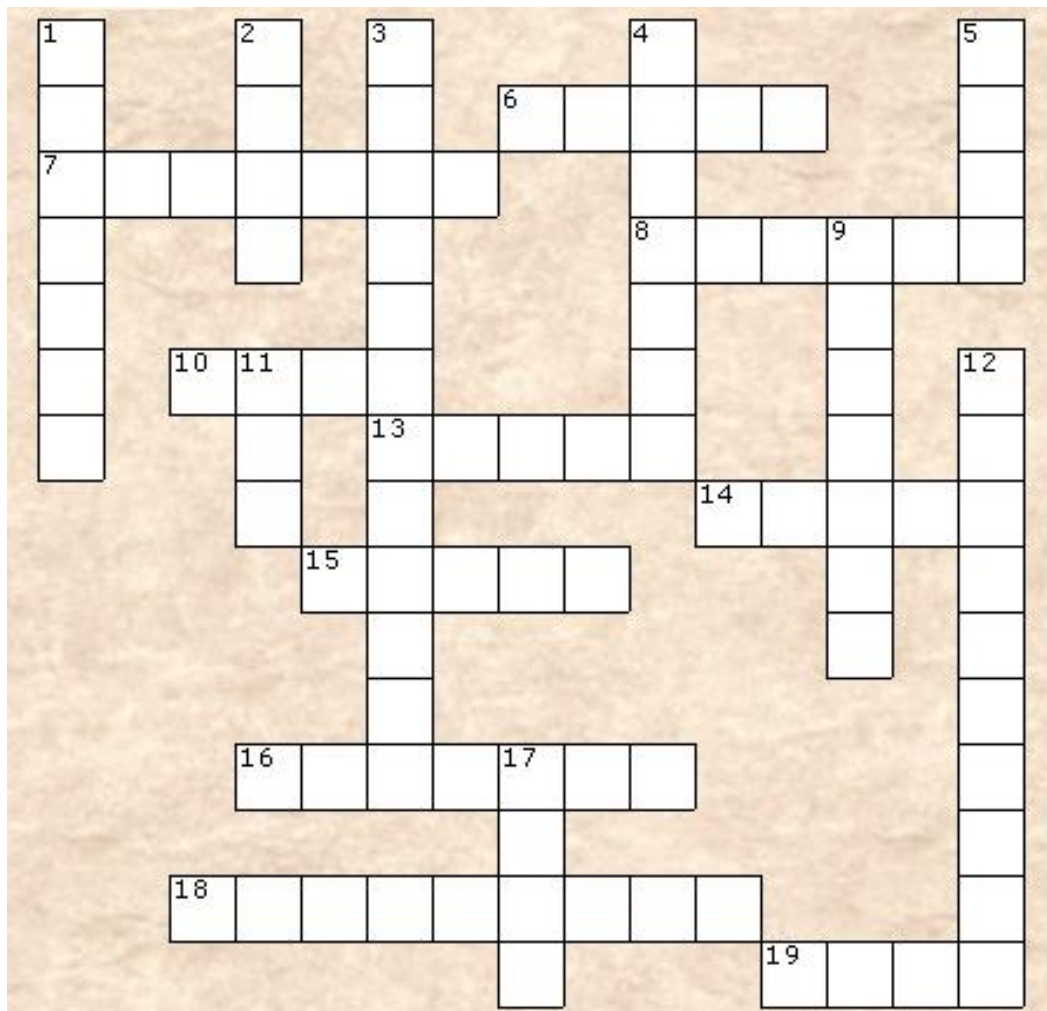
- **We are happy to report the baptism of Kiana Klein on July 12th.**
