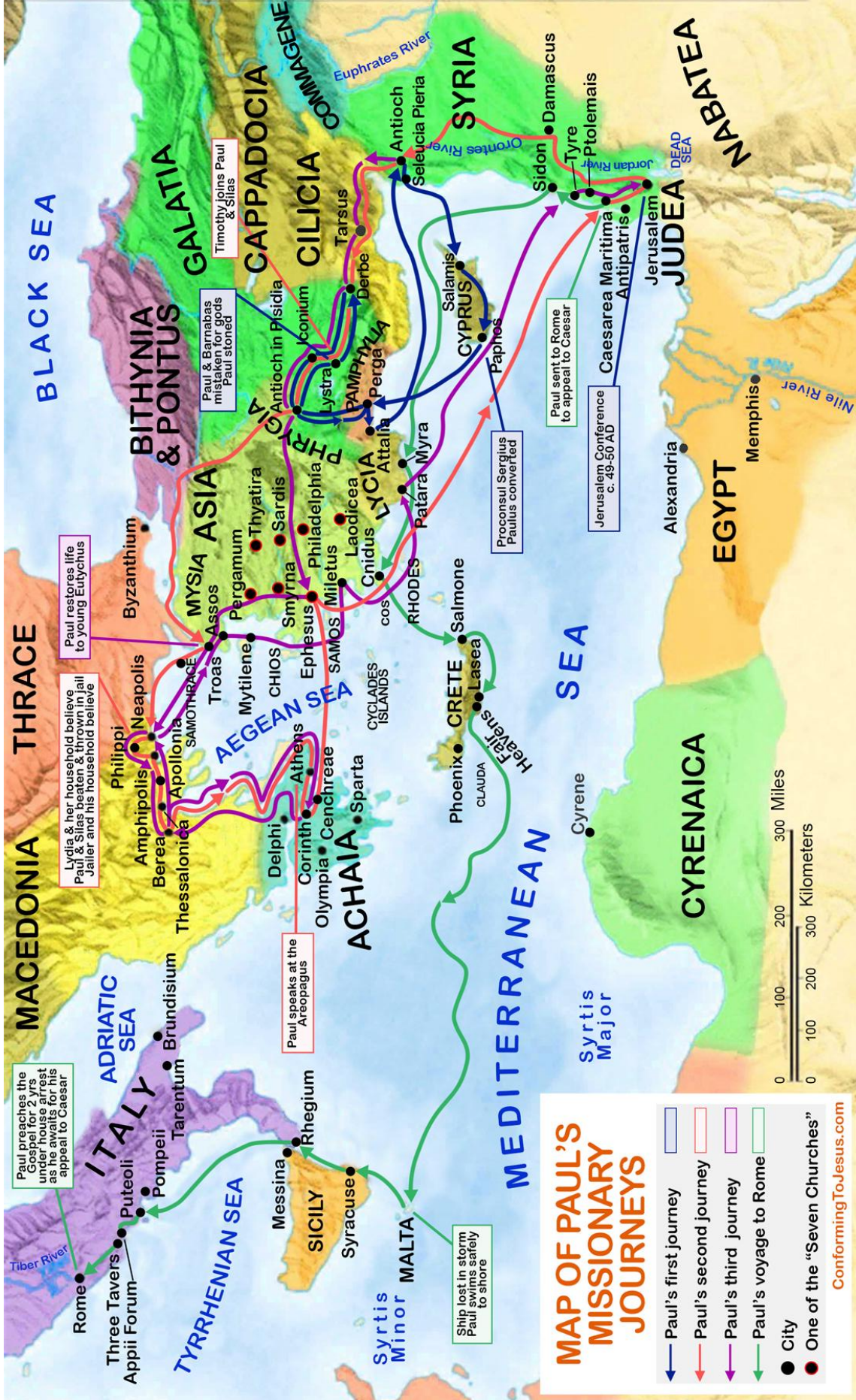


Timeline of the Life of Paul

- 5 Born—an Israelite—in Tarsus of Cilicia (Acts 22:3&8; Phil 3:5)
- 15-20 School of Gamaliel in Jerusalem (Acts 22:3)
- 32 Stoning of Stephen (Acts 7:58 and 8:1)
- 34 Conversion of Saul of Tarsus (A9:1-22,22:1-16,26:9-20,G1:13-16)
- 34-37 Damascus/Arabia (revelations?) (A9:23-25,G1:17, 2 C. 11:32)
- 37 First return visit to J. after 3 yr - Nero born (A9:26-28,22:17-21,G1:18-20)
- 37-45 Preaches in Tarsus of Cilicia (revelations?)(A9:30, G1:21-24)
- 46 Brought from Tarsus to Antioch by Barnabas, (A11:26-30)
Agabus prophesied about famine (Acts 11:27-28)
Paul's second visit to Jerusalem, with the collection (Acts 11:29-30)
- 47 Paul, Barnabas and John Mark return to Antioch (A12:25)
- 47-48 Paul & Barnabas 1st Journey (A13-14)
- 49 Jerusalem Apostolic Council (3rd time to J. 14 years)(A15,G2:1)
- 49-53 Paul & Silas 2nd Journey (A16-18) (**Writes Galatians, 1-2 Thessalonians**)
- 53-57 Paul's 3rd Journey (A18-A21) (**Writes 1-2 Corinthians, Romans**)
- 58-59 Arrest Sanhedrin, Felix, Festus, Agrippa (A21-A26)
- 59-61 Sails for Rome, Shipwrecked, Arrives in Rome (A27-A28)
- 61-62 (**Writes Philemon, Colossians, Ephesians, Philippians**)
- 62-65 Prison Release and travels 64 - Rome Fire (**Writes 1 Timothy & Titus**)
- 65 Reimprisoned (**Writes 2 Timothy**)
- 66 Martyrdom by Beheading
- 68 Nero's suicide
- 70 Destruction of Temple under Titus
